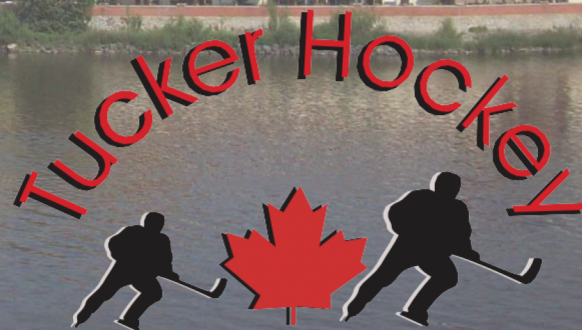

- Prague attracts the 5th most visitors of all the major cities in Europe.
- Explore the beautiful center of Prague: historic Charles Bridge, Prague Castle, the Astronomical Clock in the Old Town Square and the captivating Vltava River.
